

**BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN (BMA)  
MINUTES FOR  
SPECIAL CALL MEETING ON  
January 3, 2023**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Tullahoma, Coffee and Franklin Counties, Tennessee assembled at the Municipal Building, in Tullahoma, for a Special Call meeting on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Ray Knowis presiding and the following named members of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen: Jenna Amacher, Daniel Berry, Kurt Glick, Jerry Mathis, and Bobbie Wilson. All Board Members were present.

Jennifer Moody, City Administrator; Stephen M. Worsham, City Attorney and Rosemary Golden, City Recorder were present at the meeting.

Mayor Ray Knowis called the meeting to order.

City Recorder, Rosemary Golden, read the special call notice and then she called the roll. She asked that each of the Aldermen present sign the acknowledgement notice tonight.

The Invocation was said by Rev. Elbert Smith and he led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The vote being five (5) for Mr. Derick Mann and one (1) for Mr. Tommy Northcutt; Mr. Derick Mann will fill the vacancy on the Tullahoma Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the remainder of an unexpired term, ending upon the election of a qualified successor in the august 2024 election.

Mayor Knowis stated that if there were no objections, we would have a swearing in ceremony at 4:30 on Monday, January 8, 2023. There were no objections.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen at this time, the Board Meeting adjourned at 6:06p.m.
